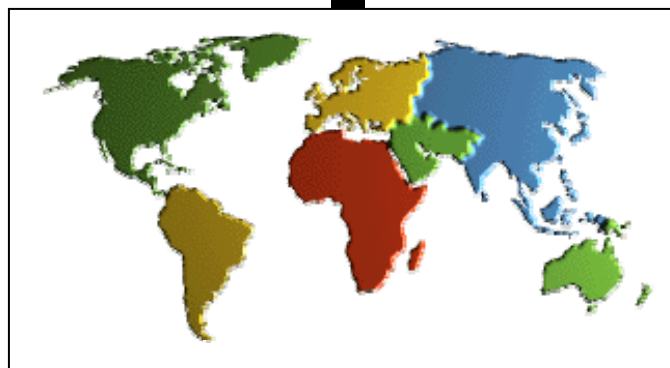

MOBILE INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL LANGUAGE HUNT: COUNTRIES/LANGUAGES/CONTINENTS TEACHERS INSTRUCTIONS:

***PREPARE THE STUDENTS BY HAVING THEM ALL
COME WITH COPIES OF THE WORKSHEET, COME PREPARED!***

- DON'T ASK THE STUDENTS TO COMPLETE THIS BEFORE COMING TO THE FESTIVAL. HAVE THEM FIND THE INFORMATION AT THE FESTIVAL.
- ASSIGN THE STUDENTS TO TEAMS OR HAVE STUDENTS WORKS SEPARATELY WITH THE DIFFERENT LISTS, THEN BRING THEM TOGETHER TO DISCUSS THEIR LISTS – USE ALL THREE PAGES – EACH PAGE HAS A DIFFERENT SET OF COUNTRIES AND THE LANGUAGE LIST GOES ACROSS THE THREE PAGES.
- NOT ALL COUNTRIES ARE REPRESENTED AT THE MOBILE INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL. THOSE WITHOUT AN ASTERISK ARE COUNTRIES THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH ALABAMA FACULTY, STAFF OR STUDENTS WORK WITH IN ADDITION TO ALL THE COUNTRIES REPRESENTED AT THE FESTIVAL.

HOW TO FIND THE ANSWERS AT THE FESTIVAL:

1. FIND THE COUNTRY AND ASK THEM TO HELP WITH THE LANGUAGE AND THE CONTINENT.
2. FOR THOSE THEY CANNOT FIND COME BY HAVE THE STUDENTS DO A WEB SEARCH

WHEN YOU GET BACK TO CLASS HAVE THE STUDENTS

- A. LOOK UP THE INFORMATION ON THE WEB AND COMPLETE THE LANGUAGES AND CONTINENTS.
- B. WHO GOT ALL THE LANGUAGES CORRECT?
- C. WHO GOT ALL THE COUNTRIES CORRECT?
- D. PULL OUT A WORLD MAP AND HAVE THEM FIND THE COUNTRIES ON THE MAP
- E. FIND THE CONTINENTS ON THE MAP
